

# LITHUANIAN OPEN SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2013

## Regulations

### I. PLACE AND TIME

The championships will be held in **Kaunas, 27-29<sup>th</sup> of June, 2013** in the 50 m swimming pool of Kaunas swimming center (Kovo 11-osios str. 26, Kaunas). This swim meet is Swimming Qualifying Event for Barcelona 2013 FINA World Championships approved by FINA.

Beginning of the competition:

27 of June (Thursday):	Heats – 10.30, Finals – 17.00;
28 of June (Friday):	Heats – 10.00, Finals – 16.45;
29 of June (Saturday):	Heats – 10.00, Finals – 16.00;

Entry into the swimming pool 60 min before the beginning of the competition.

Lithuanian Swimming Federation's members who have paid the members fees, and guests from abroad.

#### V. ENTRIES

- Technical entries must be sent before **17:00 o'clock of 18 of June, 2013.**
- The last corrections can be made till **26 of June 10:30, 2013.**
- Entries with doctors visas to take part in competition should be submitted before the beginning of the competition.
- The swimmers from abroad can take part in the competitions. They have to follow the same rules as well. Every entry time has to be confirmed, with the achieved date and place.
- Every participating organization can register more than one team in the relays.
- One swimmer can participate only in one relay team.
- Entries times have to be achieved in period from May 1 2012 till June 17 2013.
- Entries must be submitted by using „**ENTRY EDITOR**“
- It should be indicated swimming result (if there is no result – write NT), length of swimming pool, date of achievement (not the name of the competition)
- Filled application forms (entries) must be sent to the Lithuanian Swimming Federation. The file name must be the same as the name of the team. (For example: Kauno PM, Vilniaus VCM..)
- All entries must be sent **only by e-mail. [lpf.paraiskos@gmail.com](mailto:lpf.paraiskos@gmail.com)**
- Entries will not be accepted after the deadline.
- Entries consider accepted after you have got confirmation (reply).
- Swimmers, who's achieved results mismatch with the results from technical entry, will start with mark „NT“(no time).
- If there is no achieved result in 50 m swimming pool, the result could be written achieved in 25 m swimming pool.
- Achieved times in 25 m swimming pool will be listed after all achieved times in 50 m pool.
- **No possible correction after the start list is printed (after 26 th of June 2013, 10:30 AM).**

#### VI. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- FINA rules are applied.
- Competition results will be recorded with OMEGA Ares 21 timing system.
- A competition is held with heats and finals.
- Every swimmer has to make registration before the heats of the event.
- Relays are held only in the evening section (finals).
- Applications forms for the relays, with the names of the swimmers, must be given to the secretary of the competition 60 min before the start of the finals.

- 400 IM, 800 FREE, 1500 FREE will be slowest heats in the morning session and the fastest heat will be in the evening session.
- 400 FREE will be only "A" final.
- It will be held „A“ and „B“ finals if there were registered more than 24 swimmers in the heats of the event.
- It will be held „A“ final, if there were registered 9-23 swimmers in the event.
- If there are 8 or less swimmers registered in the event, it will be held directly in the finals.
- First will be held „B“ final, and after it „A“ final.
- 2 substitutes swimmers for the finals are announced, and they must arrive into call room, before the final.
- The refusal form (if you want to scratch the swimmers from the finals) must be given to the secretary of the competition no later than 30 min after the heats are over.
- Penalty fee for not attending to the start – 10 Litas (heats or finals), relay – 40 Litas.
- Penalty fee for unperformed qualify time – 10 Litas.
- Lithuanian Open Swimming Championships is a public event, which may be videotaped and Photographed.
- The team submitting the application confirms that the participants agrees with the video or Photo material distribution in the media or internet.
- Swimsuits must be on FINA approved swimsuit list. **No Arena Carbon Pro suits (FINA codes: AR220993, AR220994, AR141364).**

## VII. AWORD

- Event winners will be determined in accordance with FINA rules and awarded with diplomas and medals.
- Lithuanian champions and medal winners may only become citizens of Lithuania.
- Foreign athletes participating in competitions, have the right to participate in the finals, but can not qualify for the awards.

## VIII. PROTESTS

- All protests must be made in writing with deposit of 100 Lt.
- Meet Referee will consider protests according FINA rules
- In case of granted protest, 100 Lt deposit will be returned.

## IX. FINANCIAL TERMS

- All expenses must be covered by sending organization
- Entry fee for non LTU swimming members – 10 Euro.
