

ALYTUS “GRAND PRIX” SWIMMING COMPETITION 2022.12.09-10

I. ORGANIZERS

1.1 The swimming competition is organized by clubs: „ŠILAINIAI“ and “Vandens sporto šakų akademija”.

II. DATE AND PLACE

Place: Alytus, 50 meters pool, 8 lanes, times will be recorded with electronics, address is Naujoji str. 52 (internet site - - <http://baseinas.asrc.lt/>)

Date: 8-11, December 2022

2.1 2022/12/08 d. from 18.00- 21.00 hours possible time to swim, do starts-need to order earlier.

2.2 2022/12/09 d. warm up 15.00 h., event starts 16.00 h.

2.3 2022/12/10 d. warm up 9.30 h., event starts 10.30 h.

III. COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS AND PROGRAM

- I. age group: girls and boys born in 2008
- II. age group: girls and boys born in 2009
- III. age group: girls and boys born in 2010
- IV. age group: girls and boys born in 2011
- V. age group: girls and boys born in 2012
- VI. age group: girls and boys born in 2013
- VII. age group: girls and boys born in 2007 and older

Note: In the 200m events, athletes of all age groups participate together in the "Open class" group and only the 3 girls and 3 boys who achieve the fastest results are awarded.

IV. WINNERS AND AWARD CEREMONY

- 4.1. Competition will be conducted in accordance with FINA (International Swimming Federation) and Lithuanian swimming federation rules, competition is individual, one start rule.
- 4.2. The number of starts is not limited.
- 4.3. Before entering the race, the participant must register at the participants judge in the call room. In case of not showing up, the participant will not be allowed to participate in the event.
- 4.4. Each group winners will be rewarded with I place medals (if there will be a possibility and prizes), second and third place winners will be rewarded II and III place medals (if there will be a possibility and prizes).

4.5. Each group best swimmers (1 girl and 1 boy) who collected the most FINA points, with summed up 2 different events FINA points, will be rewarded with cups.

4.6. If they have the same summed up FINA points, the best swimmer will be determined by the number of medals and they places.

4.7. Athlete, which will not come to the medals ceremony, may loose the prize.

V. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION CONDITIONS

5. 1. Applications can be submitted to info@alytusgrandprix.lt:

- Applying until 2022. November 28 23:59 the fee for each start is - 7.00 (seven EUR 00 ct).
- If the application is submitted after 2022 November 29 00:00, until 2022 December 2 12:00 p.m. reads "late application" for all participants. The fee for each start is 10.00 (ten EUR 00 ct).
- When submitting technical applications, the teams must finally decide how many and which events a certain participant will swim, as it will not be possible to change them later. Applications can be submitted in several ways:

5.2. Last changes, deletions are possible until 2022. December 8 12:00 p.m. (it is not possible to change the distances of the athletes).

5.3. The organizers reserve the right to reduce or increase the number of team participants depending on the participants. * The maximum number of participants is 600 athletes (at the same time, it will depend on the orders adopted in Lithuania related to the rules for organizing competitions). Priority will be given to those teams that registered before 18.11.2022.

5.4. Applications indicate the available result. It is **NECESSARY** to fill in the athlete's full date of birth, the exact name of the team.

5.5. No changes will be accepted after the start minutes have been printed (after 12:00 p.m. on December 8).

5.6. Competitions are conducted using the Meet Manager application.

5.7. Applications submitted later will not be accepted.

5.8. The application is considered accepted if you have received a response.

5.9. Each participant must have a health check and submit a health certificate to their organization, allowing them to start the competition. The sending organization is responsible for the health of its participants during competition and out of competition. The organizers are not responsible for injuries suffered by athletes, health deterioration, thefts.

VI. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION CONDITIONS

6.1 All sending organizations must transfer the money for the athletes' entry fee. All team club data, invoicing information, must be specified and paid by 2022. December 9

6.2. Fees must be paid before the start of the competition

6.3. Athletes from the city of Alytus are exempt from the fee (if they registered before December 2 at 12 a.m.)

7.1 Alytus Grand Prix is a public event where filming and photography can be done.

7.2. Filmed or photographed material is distributed in the media, TV channels and the Internet.
