2. Times will be recorded with „ALGE“. Swimmers will compete in 10 lanes, 50 m swimming pool.
3. Lithuanian and foreign athletes are welcomed to participate in the competition (except for Russian and Belarussian athletes who have no permission to resident in Lithuania).
4. World Aquatics rules will be applied.

7. Valid one start rule.
8. Entries must be submitted by no later than 19-06-2024, 24:00 by email:
info@kaunasgrandprix.lt
9. Changes/withdrawals will be accepted until 25-06-2024, 12:00.
10. No changes will be accepted after the 25-06-2024 12:00.
11. Each competitor must have a doctor's visa, which confirms that the athlete is healthy and can participate in the competition.
12. When submitting technical applications, the teams must finally decide how many and which events a certain participant will swim, as it will not be possible to change them later.
13. Entry fee:
 - Competition fee –25€;
 - Competition fee –12€/one event;
14. The fee must be paid for all participants included into the protocol.
15. Max 5 event for 1 athlete.
16. The participants are responsible for their own travel, accommodation, and food expenses.

18. Participation fee and fines must be paid to this account:
19. The number of participants on a non 400 (four hundred), or in excess of 700 (seven hundred), the organizers reserves the right to change the competition format. Maximum participant number is 700.
20. During the race, the pools internal rules of procedure are valid.
21. The sending organization is responsible for its participants health. Organizer is not responsible for injuries incurred by athletes, health deterioration, theft.
22. All expenses (lodging, travel) are payed by the sending organization or the participants themselves.
23. Swimmers age groups:
 - I age group: Girls and boys 2010.**
 - II age group: Girls and boys 2011.**
 - III age group: Girls and boys 2012.**
 - IV age group: Girls and boys 2013.**
 - V age group: Girls and boys 2014.**

VI age group: Girls and boys 2015 and younger.

***Note:** Athletes of all ages who take part in the 200m freestyle event will be swimming in the „Open Class“ group, and just three best's athletes will be awarded.

24. The fine for failure to comply with the standart in the distance of 200 m freestyle is 15 Euro.

Standarts is 2.50.00 min for boys and 3.20.00 for girls.

****Note:** In Kaunas Grand Prix swim meet can participate swimmers NON-COMPETITION: girls and boys 2009 and older, but without awarding. Start fee in each event- 12 Euro.

25. Award ceremony: the winners of each race, group in the 1st place will be awarded with medals and prizes, and winners of II and III places with medals (prizes if possible).

26. The participant who does not attend the award ceremony may lose the right to a prize.

27. The Vilnius swim cup is a public event, where videos and photos might be taken.

28. The filmed and photographed material may be published in the media and online.

29. The team leaders are responsible for: following the deadlines; the participants' safety during the arrival/departure and the competition; proper behavior of their athletes during the competition and the free time.

30. When submitting an application form participants agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Event.

31. The team, upon submitting the application, confirms that they have met and agreed to these regulations

32. Organizers reserve the right to change the date, time, or program of the event, if necessary.
