



REGULATIONS FOR THE "KLAIPĖDA SWIMS UNITING GENERATIONS 2025" COMPETITION

1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

- To promote the sport of swimming;
- To unite swimmers of all generations;
- To collaborate with swimmers from other countries and cities.

2. VENUE AND DATE

The competition will take place on March 29, 2025, at the Klaipėda Swimming Pool, located at Dubysos g. 12, Klaipėda.

10:00 AM – Warm-up session (45 minutes)

11:00 AM – Start of the competition.

3. PARTICIPANTS AND PROGRAM

Age groups for participants:

1. Group 1: Born in 2016 or later (boys and girls) – can only register for 50m and 100m distances.
2. Group 2: Born in 2015 (boys and girls)
3. Group 3: Born in 2014 (boys and girls)
4. Group 4: Born in 2013 (boys and girls)
5. Group 5: Born in 2012 (boys and girls)
6. Group 6: Born in 2011 (boys and girls)
7. Group 7: Born in 2010 (boys and girls)
8. Group 8: Born in 2009 or earlier (boys and girls)

Masters Age Groups: A:25-29, B:30-34, C:35-39, D:40-44, E:45-49, F:50-54, G:55-59, H:60-64; I:65-69, J:70-74, K:75-79, L:80-84, M:85-89, N:90-94, P:95-99

Each participant can compete in a maximum of two events per competition session.

4. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AND AWARDS

The competition is organized by Klaipėda Swimming Club.

It is an individual competition.

The competition follows the rules approved by World Aquatics.

The one-start rule applies.

Winners and runners-up in each event and age group will receive medals and prizes.

All participants are included in a lottery to win sponsor-provided prizes.

5. REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

Technical entries must be submitted via the "Entry Editor" program by March 21, 2025, at 11:59 PM.

Withdrawals are allowed until March 27, 2025, at 11:59 PM. No changes will be accepted afterward.

Entries must be sent via email to klaipedaplaukia@gmail.com. Registration is confirmed only upon receiving a confirmation email.

Participation fee: €20 (to be paid on competition day).

6. FINAL PROVISIONS

The competition is a public event where filming and photography may take place. The recorded material may be published in the media, on TV, and online.

Team leaders are responsible for:

- Submitting documents on time.
- Ensuring participants are in good health and fit to compete.
- Ensuring the safety of participants during travel and the competition.
- Ensuring appropriate behavior of participants during the event and leisure time.

By submitting an entry, teams confirm that they are aware of and agree to abide by these regulations.

The organizers reserve the right to change the competition date, time, or program. The organizers are not responsible for injuries or theft occurring during the competition.
