I. ORGANIZERS

1.1 The swimming competition is organized by clubs: „ŠILAINIAI“ and “Vandens sporto šakų akademija”.

II. DATE AND PLACE

2.1. **Place:** Alytus, 50 meters pool, 8 lanes, times will be recorded with electronics, address is Naujoji str. 52 (internet site - <http://baseinas.asrc.lt/>)

2.2. 2025/05/01 d. from 18.00- 21.00 hours possible time to swim, do starts-need to order earlier.

2.3. 2025/05/02 d. warm up 13.00 – 13.50 h., event starts 14.00 h.

2.4. 2025/05/03 d. warm up 9.30 - 10.20 h., event starts 10.30 h.

III. COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS AND PROGRAM

I. age group: girls and boys born in 2011

II. age group: girls and boys born in 2012

III. age group: girls and boys born in 2013

IV. age group: girls and boys born in 2014

V. age group: girls and boys born in 2015

VI. age group: girls and boys born in 2016 and younger

VII. age group: girls and boys born in 2010 and older

Note: In the 200m events, athletes of all age groups participate together in the "Open class" group and only the 3 girls and 3 boys who achieve the fastest results will be awarded.

4.1. Competition will be conducted in accordance with “World Aquatics” (International Swimming Federation) and LTU Aquatics rules, competition is individual, one start rule.

4.2. The number of starts is not limited.

4.3. The fine for failure to comply with the time normative in the distances of 200 m is 15 Euro.

4.4. Before entering the race, the participant must register at the participants judge in the call room.

In case of not showing up, the participant will not be allowed to participate in the event.

4.5. Each group winner will be rewarded with I place medals (if there will be a possibility and prizes), second and third place winners will be rewarded II and III place medals (if there will be a possibility and prizes).

4.6. Athlete, which will not come to the medal's ceremony, may lose the prize.

V. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION CONDITIONS

5. 1. Applications can be submitted to info@alytusgrandprix.lt:

- Applying until 2025. April 18 th. 23.59 participant fee – 20.00 EUR 00 cnt.
- If the application is submitted after 2025 April 18 th. 00:00, until 2025 May 1 d. 12.00 h. reads "late application" for all participants. The fee for each start is 10.00 EUR 00 cnt.

5.2. Last changes, deletions are possible until 2025. May 1 12:00 a.m. (it is not possible to change the distances of the athletes).

5.3. The organizers reserve the right to reduce or increase the number of team participants depending on the participants. * The maximum number of participants is 600 athletes (at the same time, it will depend on the orders adopted in Lithuania related to the rules for organizing competitions). Priority will be given to those teams that registered before 18.04.2025.

5.4. Applications indicate the available result. It is NECESSARY to fill in the athlete's full date of birth, the exact name of the team.

5.5. No changes will be accepted after the start minutes have been printed (after 12:00 p.m. on May 1).

5.6. Competitions are conducted using the Meet Manager application.

5.7. Applications submitted later will not be accepted.

5.8. The application is considered accepted if you have received a response.

5.9. Each participant must have a health check and submit a health certificate to their organization, allowing them to start the competition. The sending organization is responsible for the health of its participants during competition and out of competition. The organizers are not responsible for injuries suffered by athletes, health deterioration, thefts.

VI. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION CONDITIONS

6.1 All sending organizations must transfer the money for the athletes' entry fee. All team club data, invoicing information, must be specified and paid by 2025. May 2

6.2. Fees must be paid before the start of the competition.

VII. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

7.1 The participants who does not attend the award ceremony may lose the right to a prize.

7.2 The Alytus Grand prix is a public event, where videos and photos might be taken.

7.3 The filmed and photographed material may be published in the media and online.

7.4 The team leaders are responsible for: following the deadlines; the participants' safety during the arrival/departure and the competition; proper behavior of their athletes during the competition and the free time.

7.5 When applying form participants agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Event.

7.6 The team, upon submitting the application, confirms that they have met and agreed to these regulations
