The Latvian Swimming Federation in cooperation with Estonian Aquatic Sports School invites you to the **IV Open Baltic Artistic Swimming Championships!**

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**Competition dates: December 6<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

**Venue:**

Swimming pool meeting with dimensions 21×50 m with depth 1.98 – 2.33 m. Competition area 21×25 m, with depth 2.30 m.



**Referee:** Anton Rzhanov

**Chief Recoder:** Maria Popova

**Rules:** The competitions are held in accordance with latest World Aquatics 2022-2025 rules.

**Entries: Participants.** All countries national teams and clubs affiliated by their Federations are eligible to participate in the Baltic Artistic Swimming Championships.

**Age groups:**

- AG8 (born in 2017 and younger);
- AG10 (born in 2015 and younger);
- AG12 (born in 2013 and younger);
- AG15 (born in 2010 - 2013);
- Juniors (born in 2007 – 2011 female and born in 2006-2011 male);
- Beginners (born in 2011 - 2018).

**For National Teams and clubs from Baltic region is allowed to register:**

- AG8, AG10, AG12 and AG15 – figures only;
- AG10, AG12 and AG15 - 3 Solos female, 3 Solos male, 2 Duets, 2 Mixed Duets, 1 Team and 1 Combination;
- Juniors – 3 Tech Solos, 3 Free Solos, 2 Tech Duets, 2 Free Duets, 1 Free Team and 1 Acrobatic;
- Beginners – Technical Solos\* and Technical Duets\*

**For National Teams and clubs outside Baltic region is allowed to register:**

- AG8, AG10, AG12 and AG15 – figures only;
- AG10, AG12 and AG15 - 2 Solos female, 2 Solos male, 2 Duets, 2 Mixed Duets, 1 Team and 1 Combination;
- Juniors – 2 Tech Solos, 2 Free Solos, 2 Tech Duets, 2 Free Duets, 1 Free Team and 1 Acrobatic;



- Beginners – Technical Solos\* and Technical Duets\*

*\*Rules of Beginners Technical Solo and Technical Duets will be sent in a separate document.*

In each age group one national team/club can enter up to 12 participants (if a team enters a Mixed Duet, then it can add one or two participants according to the age of the competitive category).

#### **Competition events and awards:**

##### **AG8:**

- Figures: 100%;

##### **AG10:**

- Figures: 100%;
- Free routine (Solo female, Solo male, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team, Combination): 100%;

##### **AG12 and AG15:**

- Figures: 100%
- Figures: 100% + free routine (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team): 100%;
- Free Combination 100%.

##### **Juniors:**

- Technical routine (Solo, Duet): 100%;
- Free routine (Solo, Duet, Team): 100%;
- Acrobatic: 100%.

##### **Beginners:**

- Technical Routine (Solo, Duet): 100%

**Awarding Ceremony:** Medals and diplomas will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places:

- Among the national teams and clubs of the Baltic countries (Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia);
- Among all participating teams (national teams / clubs).

All AG8, AG10 and Beginners Technical Solo/Duet athletes will be awarded diplomas for participation.

**The Baltic Cup will be played among the Baltic countries.**

**Figures:** Following the World Aquatics rules each AG15 athlete participating in the figures competition will swim 2 figures.

AG8 and AG10 figures will be sent in a separate document along with the invitation and entry form.

##### **Time limits:**

- For AG8, AG10, AG12 and AG15: Solo 2:00 min., Duet/Mixed Duet 2:30 min., Team 3:00 min., Combi 3:00 min.;
- For Juniors: Tech Solo 2:00 min., Free Solo 2:15 min., Tech Duet 2:20 min., Free Duet 2:45 min., Free Team 3:30 min., Acrobatic 3:00 min.
- For Beginners: Tech solo 1:30 min, Tech Duet 1:45 min.

The timing error can be 5 seconds.

##### **Entry fee – 35 €**

If competitor participants only in figures session, then his participation fee is 15 €.

*Competitor can take part in both figures sessions (for example can take part in AG8 and AG10) if he meets the age criteria. In this case, the payment is calculated from participation in two events (Figures + Figures = 30 euros).*



Competitors who compete in *Beginners Tech.Solo* or *Beginners Tech.Duet* has the right to compete in figure session if he meet an age criteria.  
In the Routines part of competition competitor has the right to compete in only one age group.

Each participating club and/or national federation is required to bring judges and DTCs/STCs

- 1-4 participants 1 official
- 5-9 participants 2 officials
- 10+ participants 3 officials

WA-listed DTCs/STCs or judges who have passed the test at a World Aquatics school and the latest on-line-test are preferred; however, clubs/nations can choose to send any judge official eligible to judge at national level. Cost on not presenting an eligible judge/official for the competition is **300 EURO**.

### SUBMISSION OF THE MUSIC

In accordance with the World Aquatics Rules and Regulations, Artistic Swimming (AS), section 15.3 (Music Accompaniments). Method 2, please submit the music electronically via **wetransfer.com** to the contact address [info@swimming.lv](mailto:info@swimming.lv) with copy to [competition@evk.edu.ee](mailto:competition@evk.edu.ee). Each file should be clearly labelled "age\_group\_routine\_name of the competitors/team\_name of the club/national federation.mp3" as the examples: **AG12\_free team\_Crocodiles\_EST.mp3** or **AG10\_free duet\_Kask\_Tamm\_EST.mp3**  
All coaches are highly recommended to have another copy of the music as backup.

The deadline for submitting coach cards is November 21, 2025. Since in the Championship schedule no preliminaries, if necessary, an updated coach cards can be submitted on December 4, 2025, between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM (EEST).

If necessary, Team Leaders must provide documents identifying the athletes (passport or other travel document).
