### I. VENUE, DATE, PROGRAM

## Competition Program

### PRELIMINARY HEATS

Warm-up – 10:00 (Girls, Boys)

Competition Start – 11:00

Final heats planned at 16:00, but not earlier than one hour after preliminary heats.

## II. ENTRY SUBMISSION

1. Participation must be confirmed by March 23, 2026.
2. Technical entries must be submitted by March 31, 2026, 20:00.
3. Changes/withdrawals are possible until April 3, 2026, 18:00.
4. No changes will be accepted after April 3, 2026, 18:00.
5. Each participant must have a valid medical certificate confirming eligibility to compete (does not apply to participants from other countries).
6. Entries may be submitted using Entry Editor, Online system, or by email.
7. Completed entries must be sent to [info@smgriaustinis.lt](mailto:info@smgriaustinis.lt) indicating team name in file title.
8. If submitted by email, the following must be included: first name, last name, full date of birth, events, entry times. Entries not meeting requirements will not be accepted.

### **III. COMPETITION PROCEDURE**

9. Results are recorded using the ALGE Timing electronic timing system.
10. In preliminary heats, each participant may compete in no more than 3 events.
11. The competition is conducted with preliminary and final heats for all age groups.
12. Participants in fin events are given no more than 1:30 minutes to prepare before the start.
13. Final heats are formed according to results achieved in preliminary heats. Final A – places 1–8. Start time of finals may be changed.
14. Preliminary heats are held in the morning session; finals take place in the evening session under special lighting.
15. Events with 8 or fewer participants are swum only as finals (applies to all events and all age groups).
16. Two reserve swimmers are announced for each final and must report to the call room.
17. Withdrawal from a final must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes before the start of finals.

### **IV. AWARDING**

18. Winners and prize-winners in all age groups achieving the best results in finals are awarded I, II, III place medals and prizes (if available).
19. If a final heat does not take place due to fewer than eight participants, winners are determined according to preliminary results.
20. Organizers may establish additional prizes.

### **V. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

21. Entry fee – 25 € per participant.

23. Entry fee must be paid for all participants included in the start protocol.
24. Travel, accommodation and meal expenses are covered by the participating organization.

## **VI. FINAL PROVISIONS**

25. Swim Night Star – 2026 is a public event where filming and photography may occur.
26. By submitting an entry, teams and participants confirm that they have read and agree to these regulations.
27. Organizers reserve the right to change the competition date, time or program if necessary.
28. If fewer than 250 participants register, the competition may be postponed.
29. If more than 600 participants register, organizers reserve the right to limit the number of participants.
